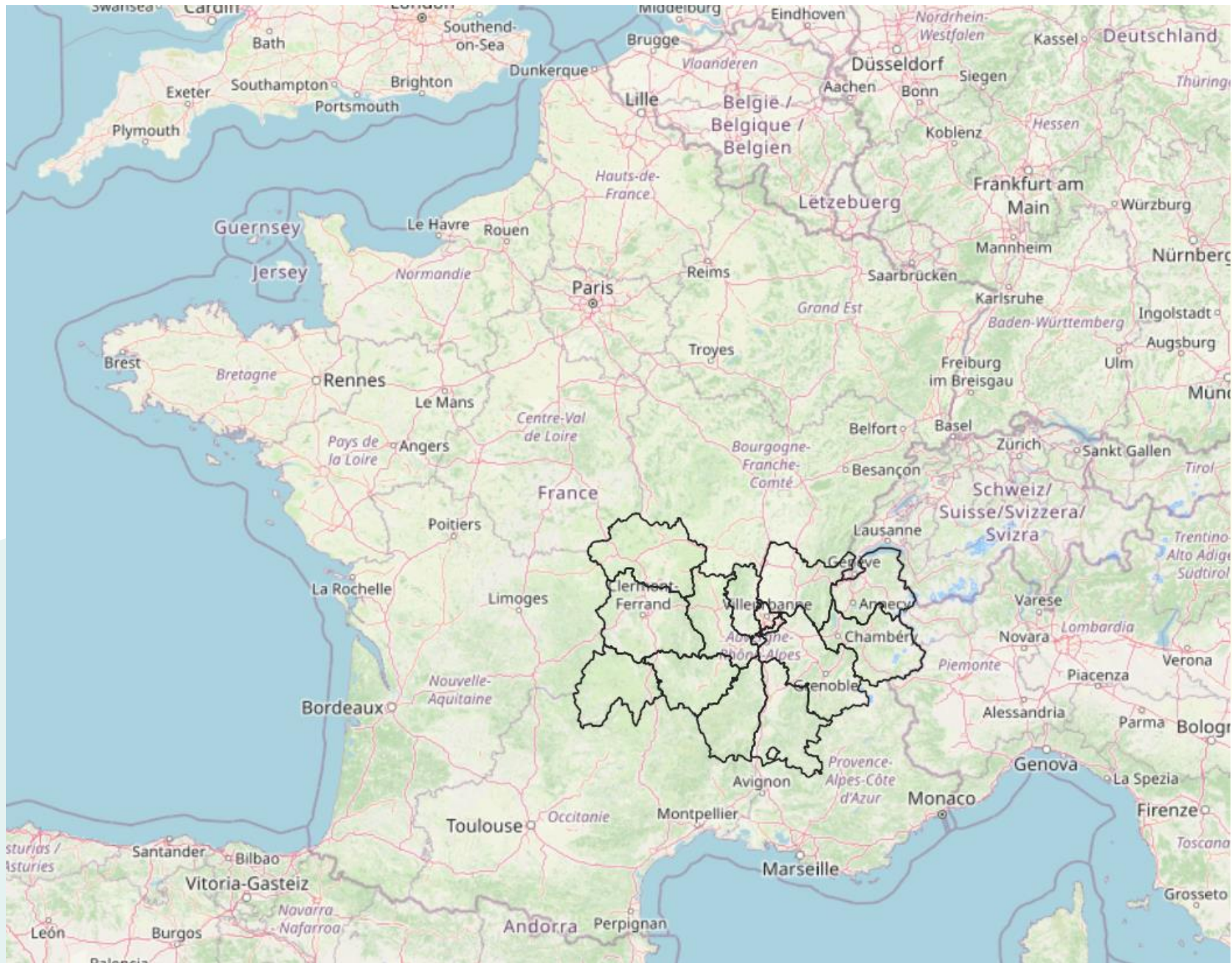
Building sector in France

- 43% of French energy consumption is for the building sector ; 23% of CO2 emissions
- Public buildings account for 1/3 of building emissions ; they are often old and consume a lot
- 76% of a municipality energy consumption is for buildings
- There are regulations to reduce the consumption of the tertiary buildings

BAPAURA goals

Development of a one-stop shop public service to support municipalities from the decision making to the end of the renovation project

- Quality service during the life of the project
- Coordination between actors of the project (municipality services, works companies, consultancies, ...)
- Unbiased technical, financial and administrative support to the municipality



Main figures of the project

- 66 public buildings renovated
- 28.3 million € of investments in energy savings works
- 4,4 GWh/year of energy savings (830 tCO₂eq)
- Build a replicable renovation support service that allows any small or mid-sized municipality to renovate their building stock

3 key points to remember

1 – A community of advisors who are trained, and share experiences

In BAPAURA, 11 partners have worked together, shared tools, best practices, ...

To provide the best service to their municipalities!

3 key points to remember

2 – Political commitment at 2 levels :

- Municipalities must be willing to make renovation works. It must be a political goal, not only the business of a technical team.
- To have an efficient service, there must be a pooled and skilled service. There must be a political will to pay for this service, organize it, ...

In BAPAURA the service is supported by associations of municipalities, or groups of municipalities

3 key points to remember

3 – Trust between the advisor and the municipality

The municipality should involve the advisor from the very beginning of the project, and not wait for problems before calling to them (it will be too late to intervene efficiently).

Municipalities should also trust their advisors, and take into account the advice they give.
