Seize Opportunities - Overcome Crises: For Clean Air and Climate Protection in Agriculture

When: on 9th June 2022 from 1pm – 6pm CET

Where: The event will take place online via Zoom

Climate change, the Corona pandemic, the war in Ukraine - all these crises also pose unforeseen challenges for agriculture, especially for young farmers. One thing is clear: climate heating does not pause when other crises come to the fore, and it remains one of the main causes of hunger worldwide. The report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) explicitly calls for the reduction of methane as well as other greenhouse gases. The high level of ammonia emissions in Germany shows no scope for unforeseen developments in the implementation of reduction measures. The German government continues to run the risk of failing to meet its reduction commitments. Removing pollutant gases from the atmosphere is necessary to get on the 1.5°C path. And it is a question of the food and farming system, which the EU's Farm to Fork strategy calls for to be transformed.

From the new German government to environmental and farmers' associations, reducing the number of animal places and changing animal husbandry practices are described as the most effective measures to address both the climate crisis and the price misery on many farms. Model studies show how agro-ecological innovations could be implemented in Europe. But what are the concrete ways to do this in Germany? What ideas and what needs do young farmers have? What do education and extension services contribute to supporting farmers in their transformation? How can the transfer of knowledge from pioneering farms to the wider community succeed? What political guidelines are needed for clean air and more climate protection, especially in times of crisis?

You are invited to discuss these and your questions during the conference.
